




I wanted to let you know about an exciting missions opportunity that will be available to the members of

EBC this coming Summer. We are in the process of planning a family mission trip to Anchorage. Alaska that will take place July 10th - 17th of 2011. This will be a wonderful experience for moms and dads to lead their children by example as they serve others

and share the good news of Jesus Christ in the least evangelized state in America. **Partnering** with a local church, we will be working in the neglected neighborhoods of Anchorage holding backyard Bible



schools in parks, evening neighborhood "Park Parties," and participating in servanthood evangelism. Children who are allowed to participate will need to have completed the fourth grade and be accompanied by one parent of the same gender. Whole families are encouraged to apply if all children meet minimum age requirements. Background checks will be required for all adults, and your family's current involvement in the ministries of EBC will be evaluated during the application process. Brantley to begin this wonderful work for God. Below is an excerpt from the North American Mission Board that answers the why question.

Why Plant New Churches

It is easy to assume that North Americans are over churched. But in reality, North America is a mission field so populous that it cannot be reached for Christ without starting large numbers of new churches. God is beginning a movement of church planting in North America--will you join Him? Invest in eternity.

Why new churches....

Because The church to population ratio is declining rapidly.

- In 1900 there were 27 churches for every 10,000 Americans.
- In 1950 there were 17 churches for every 10,000 Americans.
- In 1996 there were **11** churches for every 10,000 Americans. **[1]**

Many people look at these numbers and question, "But hasn't the size of churches increased?" Unfortunately, the answer is "no". The median size of the church has remained the same for the past 100 years.

Because new churches are much more effective at reaching the lost than established congregations. "Among evangelical churches, those under three years old will win ten people to Christ per year for every hundred church members; three to fifteen years old will win five people per year. After age 15, the number drops to three per year."

I would like to ask you to pray for Harvest Community Church, and then pray for God to show you if there is something you could do to partner with us as we work together to fulfill The Great Commission of our Lord.










Many people are aware that one of our beloved pastors' favorite verses is Psalm 127:2, "It is vain for you to rise up early." While I could give some refuting exegesis from other passages (Jesus got up early), that is not the purpose of this article. I do want to talk about "early" though, because I was reminded of the importance of it in our men's Bible study just recently.

We are taking part in the Adrian Rogers discipleship training series called, "A Man of His Word:

Calling Men to Integrity and Leadership." Our lesson recently was about a man and his children. Dr. Rogers, using Psalm 127: 4-5, likened children to an arrow in the hands of a skilled and strong warrior/archer. During the lesson, he listed 7 ways for men to fashion the arrows God had given them. The very first way he mentioned was "Start early." A young, tender, green twig is easier to bend and shape than an older, hardened stick.

As I thought about that, I thought of so many things starting early would involve. One of those things means getting all the help and all the tools God has made available to parents in place so they can be used as quickly as possible. A major help God has given parents is the local church, and a major tool He has provided is the Sunday School. Imagine the bending and shaping that takes place in a child's life when, not only the parents, but other adults (like Sunday School teachers), are singing "Jesus loves me" to infants in a Sunday School class. Or, when Sunday School teachers in the pre-school department are teaching those wonderful Bible stories of David and Goliath, Jonah and the whale, the little boy with the 5 loaves and 2 fishes. What a help to have teachers teaching in the children's department as they start driving home what the Bible says about how we are to obey God and live our lives as He says.

The sad fact is that you don't have to go very far into the children's department before you have left behind the "early" and are now getting into a time when shaping that has not already been apart of the parenting process is very hard to do. "Start early" should be a call to parents everywhere. Get your children in church and in a Sunday School class as early as possible. Of course, that means that you, dad and mom, will have to be there yourselves. This also means that there is a critical need for some of you who hear a clear call from God to serve in this ministry to answer-whether in the nursery, pre-school, or children's Sunday School classes. He wants you to be involved.

Are you a parent that needs to let "early" become a part of your parenting commitment? Are you a Christian that needs to answer God's call to be involved in an "early" ministry? If the answer to either of these two questions for you is "yes," then the only two options you have is either obedience or disobedience. If the choice is disobedience, then the only consequence is misery. How about it, what is your answer to the "early" question?
